1. Occasion: The observance of the Pokhran-II event marked an important milestone in our


college's engagement with historical and scientific developments. It served as a platform for




Student Participation: Students from various departments actively participated in the event, engaging in discussions, asking questions, and sharing their perspectives on the Pokhran-II tests.
