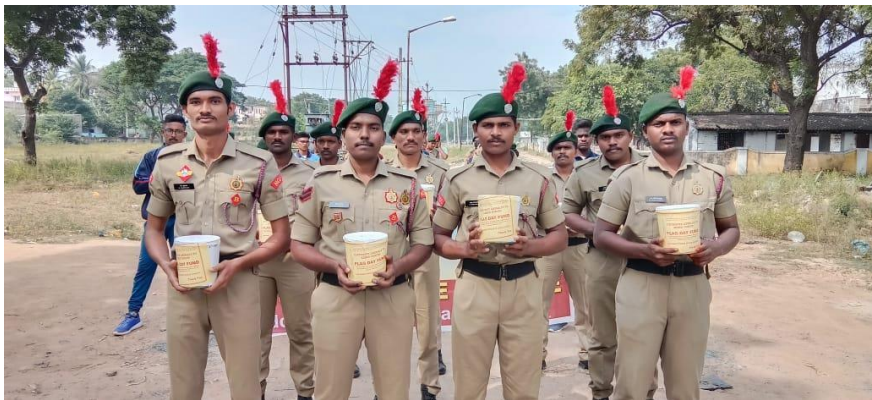

The NCC has organized a vaccination awareness drive on 21st July 2021 in a our college surrounding areas.

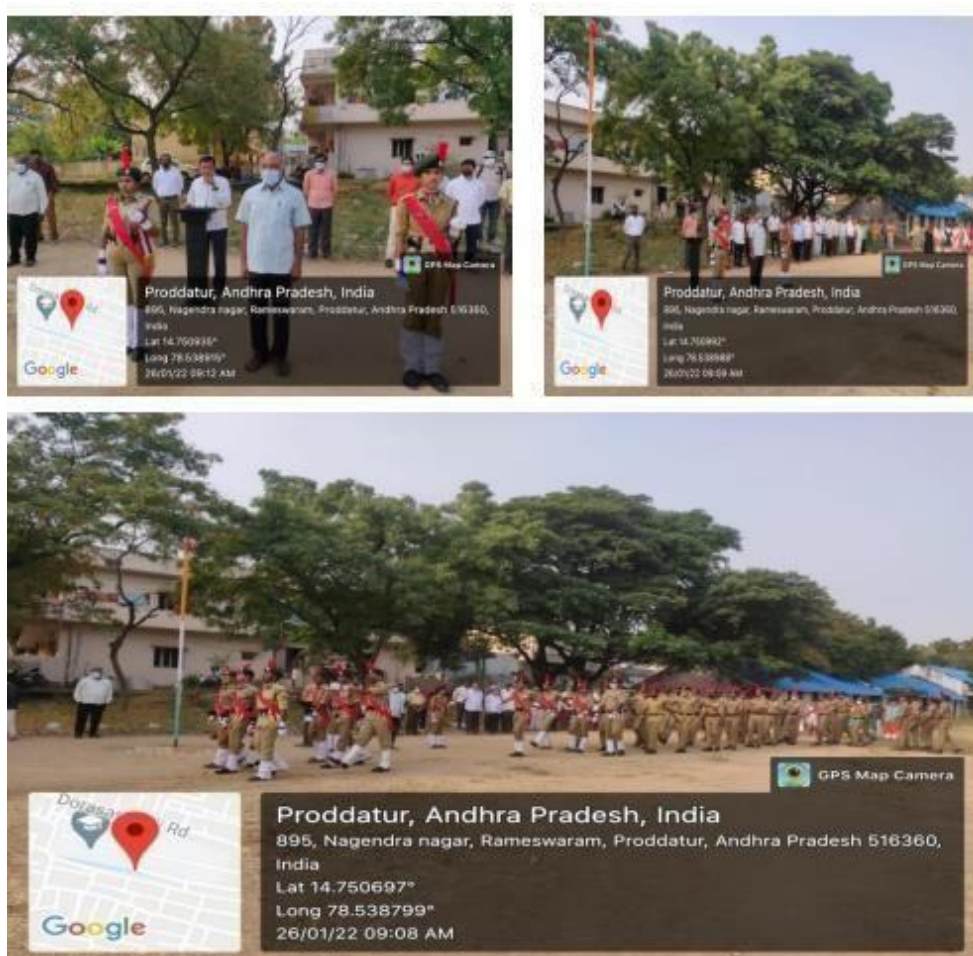

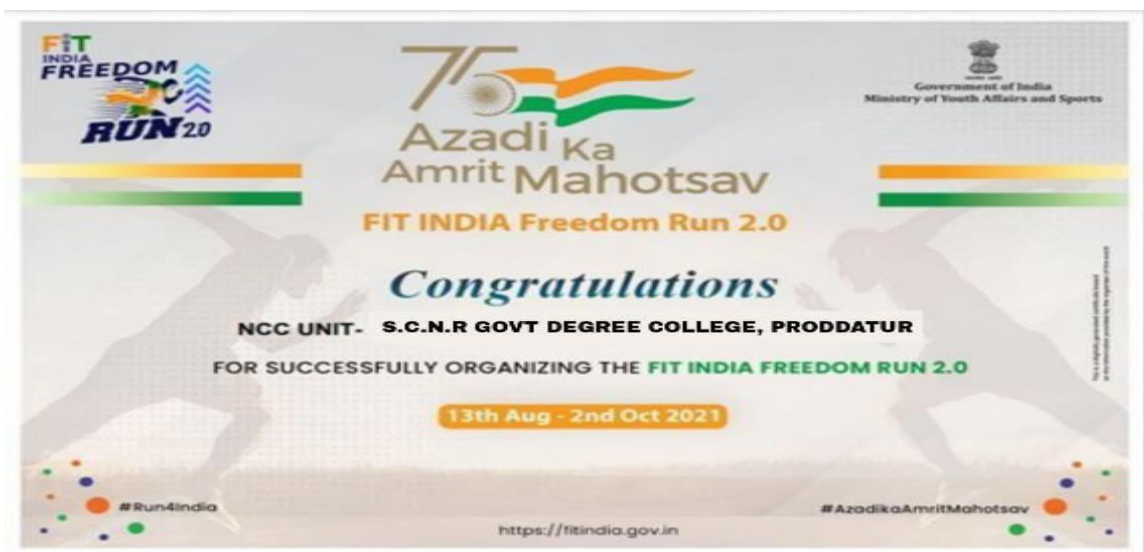


March Past by our college NCC Cadets on Independence Day in 2021.

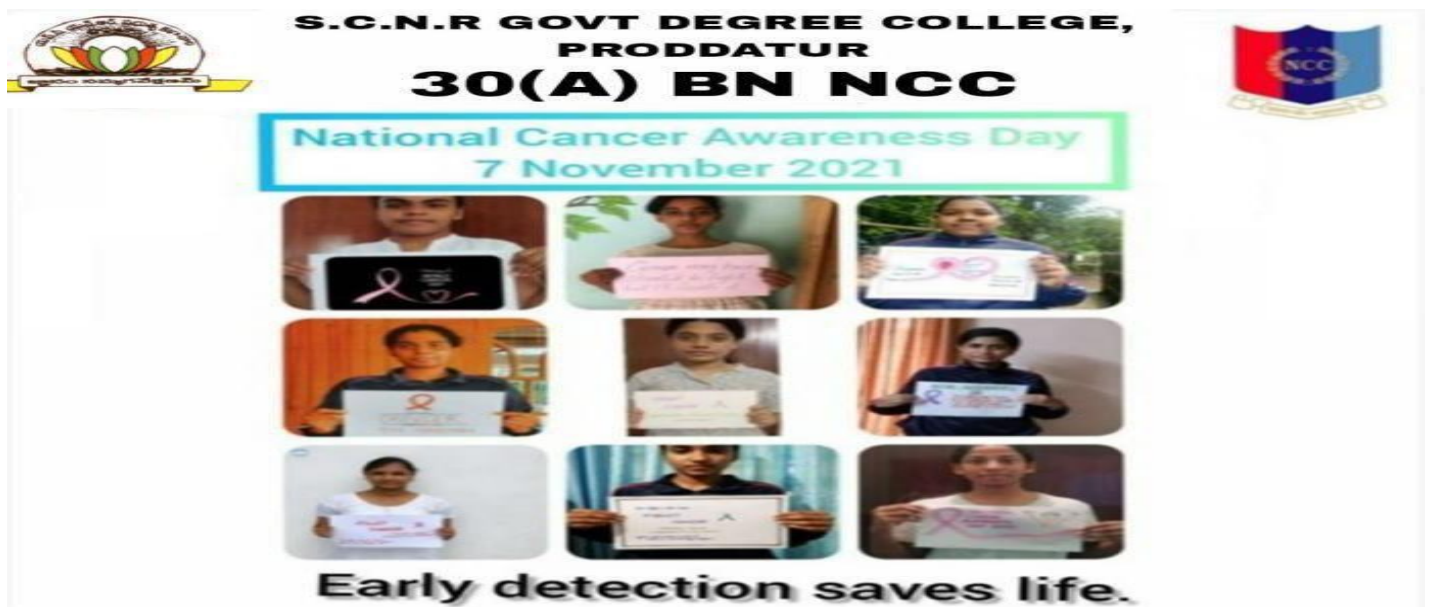
National Cancer Awareness Day

According to the World Health Organization, cancer is one of the leading causes of death worldwide. In India, nearly 1.1 million new cases of cancer were reported annually.

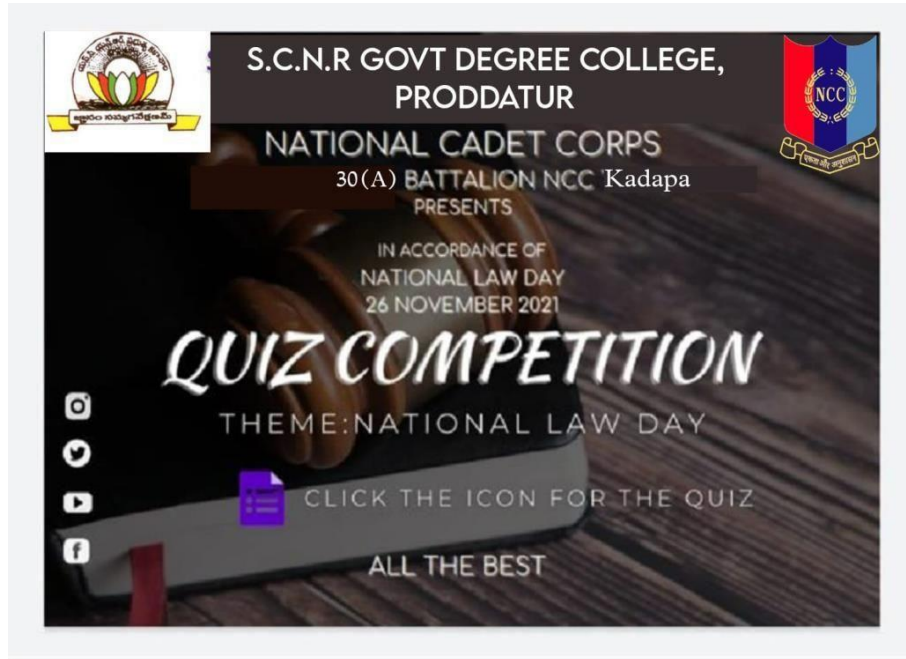

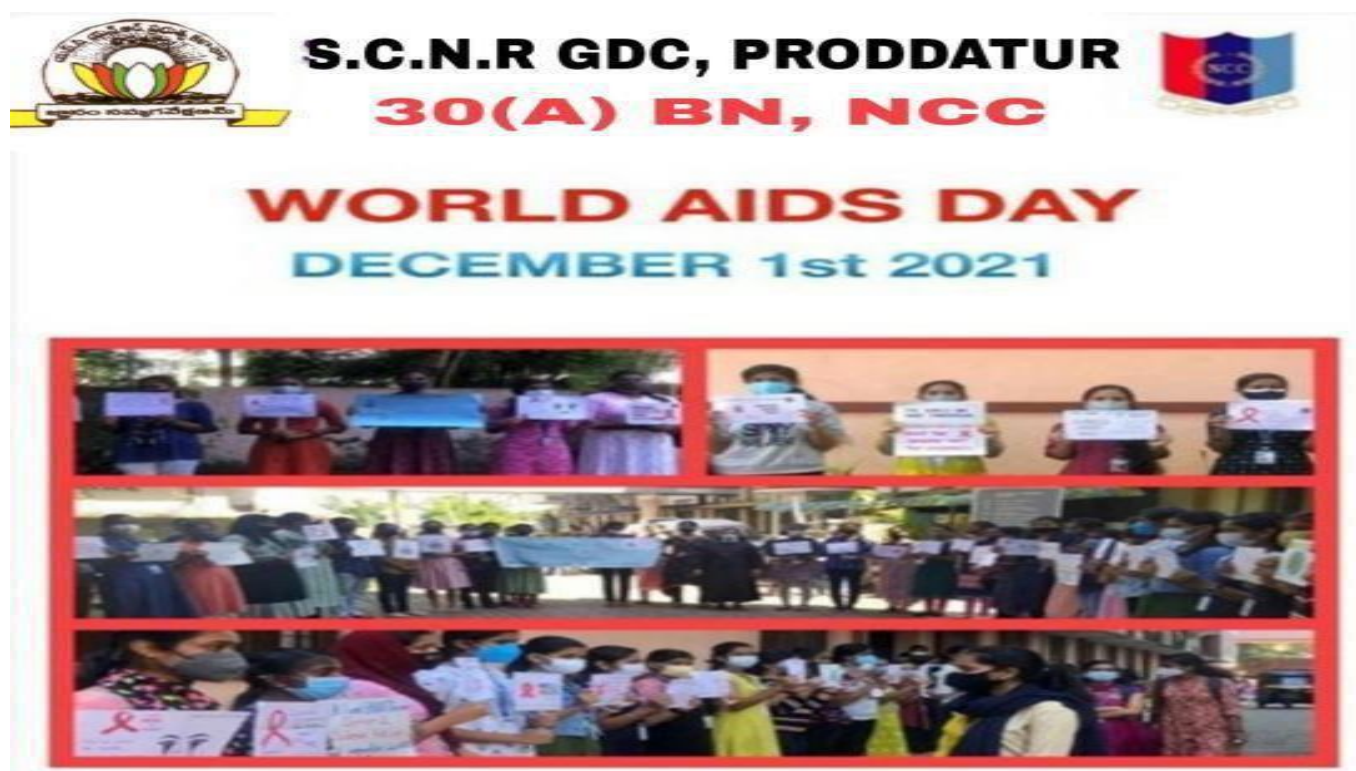

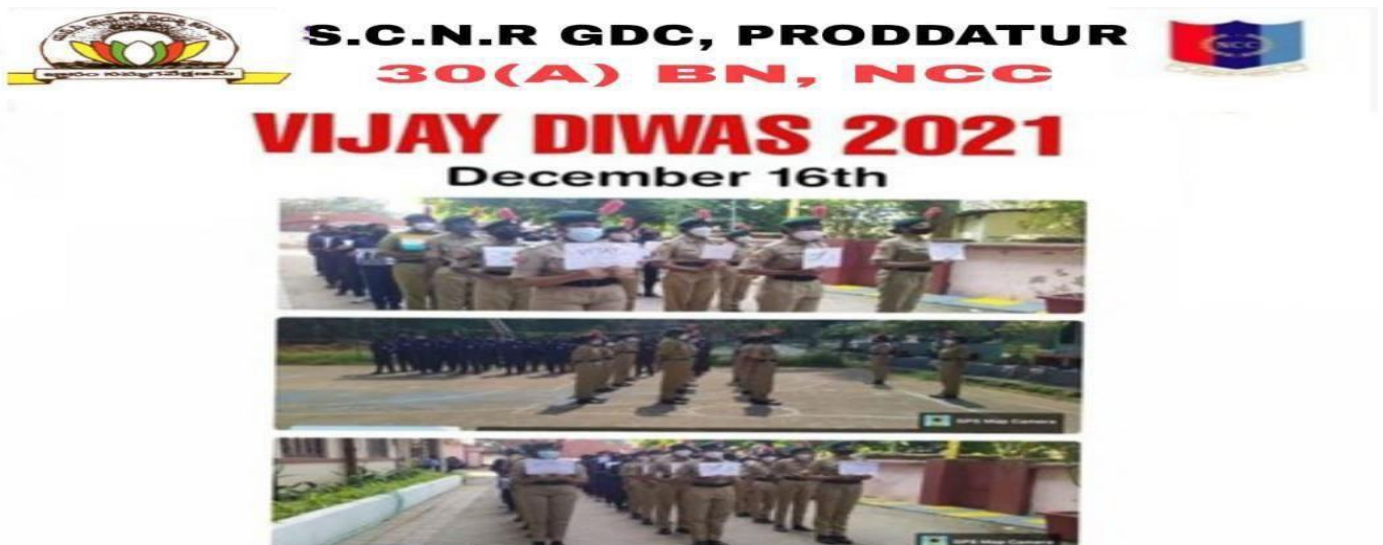
VIJAY DIWAS

The India-Pakistan war went on for a period of 13 days and India defeated Pakistan on 16th December 1971.



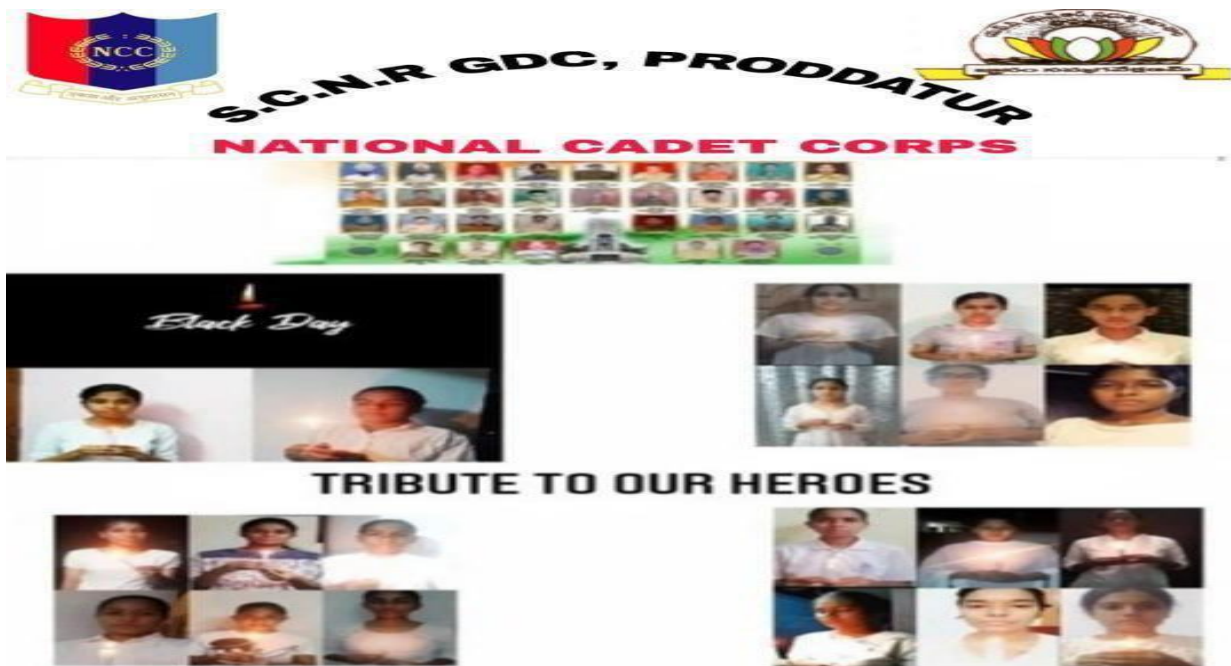

National Voters' Day

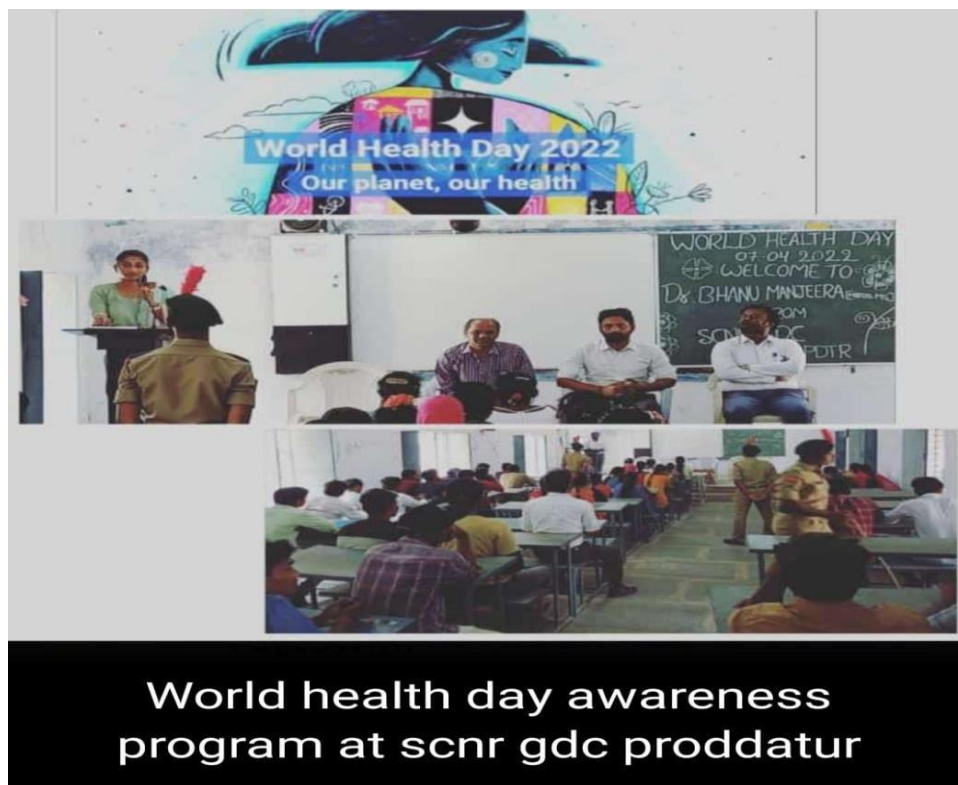
